C. DISCIPLESHIP - DEVOTIONAL TRAINING (C-1)

These 6 courses/disciplines solidify the needed foundations for Christian Devotions.
Experiencing Biblical Christianity-1 [EBC-1]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course either online or in class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum to multiply yourself. This is a basic Christian doctrinal course to interactively & experientially teach Fundamentals. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.
Personal Bible Study-1 [PBS-1]: The "saved by Grace child of God" will be asked to do a personal Bible study using the Campus Crusade for Christ - 10 Steps to Christian Maturity Bible study series. This is PART ONE and will cover "The Uniqueness of Jesus" book as well as Steps 1 to 5 of the book(s). 16 to 24 weeks required. SEE: https://www.cru.org/train-and-grow/10-basic-steps.html/main.htm
Worshipping Jesus-1 [WJ-1]: The Spirit-filled child of God will be led to worship Jesus for 15 minutes a day. This can be done through Christian music, Spirit-led worship, or verbal praise. 16 to 24 weeks required.
My Prayer Life-1 [MPL-1]: As an anointed child of God, you will be required to pray to God. This should be done in the Power of His Holy Spirit & a heart open to God. 16 to 24 weeks required.
Listening and Waiting on God-1 [LWG-1]: The BORN AGAIN child of God will listen to and wait on God and incorporate this discipline into your lifestyle. Andrew Murray said "waiting on God" was 'ABSORBING GOD'. 16 to 24 weeks required.
Bible Memorization-1 [BM-1]: Christ's child will be requested to spend time memorizing Scripture. Sections of Scripture will be suggested for memorization. This discipline renews your mind & purifies your heart. 16 to 24 weeks required.

C. DISCIPLESHIP - DEVOTIONAL TRAINING (C-2)

These 6 courses/disciplines add needed foundations for Christian Devotions.
Experiencing Biblical Christianity-2 [EBC-2]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course either online or in class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum to multiply yourself. This is a basic Christian doctrinal course to interactively and experientially teach Christian Fundamentals. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.
Personal Bible Study-2 [PBS-2]: The "saved by Grace child of God" will be asked to do a personal Bible study using the Campus Crusade for Christ - 10 Steps to Christian Maturity Bible study series. This is PART TWO covering Steps 6 to 10 of the book(s). 16 to 24 weeks required. SEE: https://www.cru.org/train-and-grow/10-basic-steps.html/main.htm
Intercessory Prayer-1 [IP-1]: God's friend will be asked to intercede for their family, their church and pastor, and for worldwide missions. 16 to 24 weeks required.
Scripture Meditation-1 [SM-1]: God's son and daughter will be asked to meditate on a different verse of Scripture on a daily basis. Then you will write a few thoughts about each scripture. 16 to 24 weeks required.
Biblical Fasting-1 [BF-1]: The delivered children of God will be asked to begin to incorporate the wonderful experience of Fasting in their life. Jesus started His ministry by fasting. 16 to 24 weeks required.
Discipleship-1 [DS-1]: The "complete in Christ child of God" will be asked to find a man or woman of God (man to man/woman to woman) to go to. You will be asked to share your life, become accountable, and pray together about God's will for your life. Good opportunity for "prayerful repentance" and learning how to be "continually filled with God's Spirit". 16 to 24 weeks required.

BIBLE MEMORIZATION 1 (BM-1)

STUDY GUIDE: BIBLE MEMORIZATION (BM-1)

TEXTBOOK/MATERIAL:

Bible www.altogetherlovely.org/useful-links

REQUIREMENTS:

God's child will be required to memorize Scripture. This will help renew your mind as well as guide you in your daily walk with God.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Decide what areas of Scripture you would like to memorize. It can be small or large sections. It can have a theme. It can be a book of the Bible, etc. Here are some examples:

• Christ's words in John's Gospel
• John Chapters 14-17 or Song of Songs Chapters 1-8
• A Book of the Bible (Colossians, Romans, etc.)
• One verse from every book in the OT, NT, or both
• A special section of Scripture (John 1; Romans 8; 1 Cor.15; etc.)
• Verses on Salvation for leading someone to Christ: Conviction (Acts 2:37); Conversion (Matthew 18:3); Repentance (Acts 2:38); Faith (John 3:36); Confession (Romans 10:9-10); Regeneration (John 3:3,5); Justification (Acts 13:39); Sanctification (1 Thess.4:3); Resurrection (Romans 8:23); Glorification (Romans 8:17)
• Verses from the Psalms (praise, God's love, etc)

* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week.

* You will be required to spend over 40 hours on this discipline over a 16 - 24 week period. This is about 15 minutes – 25 minutes a day.

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Pray before you start memorizing. Sense the Holy Spirit prompting you to begin.
- A bible verse is not memorized until you know it completely, thoroughly, and from your heart. Spend the time to learn each verse completely so you don't have to keep going back and back again.
- It is said that you need to go over a verse 100 times in order to have it for life.

ONE LAST NOTE

The student may find ONLINE study to be somewhat different from that of the On-Campus Study. However, if the student will follow the instructions, the learning will be in-depth.

The course is very "teacher/student" friendly and not difficult to lead. This Biblical Christian book is teaches the basics of Christianity experientially.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Gather 2 or more students and a leader.
* The classes require 2 hours/week for 24 weeks or 4 hours/week for 12 weeks.
* Such Christian basics as apologetics, salvation, assurance of salvation, our identity, etc. will be taught. The methodology is "experiential". It will be an interactive course that will be beneficial in experiencing Christian basics in a real way.
* To begin, read the pages for each week. Have someone prepare some worship songs. Take some time to read the "how to teach" section in the back of the book.
* After each class, complete the WEEKLY LOG below.
* 48 hours is the minimum required for this discipline [you can take 12 or 24 weeks].

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Pray before you start the class pray for about 10 minutes.
- Be focused on "growing in Christ" than in learning doctrine. Be prepared to look up words in your dictionary and to check www.altogetherlovely.org/resources.

(LWG-1)

REQUIREMENTS:

Andrew Murray once said that to “Wait on God” was to ABSORB GOD. In this course, God’s child will be required to learn to LISTEN & WAIT ON GOD. This discipline causes a person to slow down and listen to God as well as being able to hear God’s voice in a deeper manner. This is a marvelous way to grow closer to God.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Follow the following instructions in learning to Listen & Wait on God.	
	• Find a place that is quiet and without distractions. Protect this area.
	• Set aside 15 minutes/day (24 weeks) or 25 minutes/day (16 weeks).
	• Ask God to “fill you completely” in every fiber of your being.
	• Sense Jesus going into your spirit, will, emotions, mind, and body.
	• Continue to ask God to fill you with Himself.
	• Now, allow God to speak to you deep in your spirit.
	• Then, begin to write anything God has said to you.
* This is not a passive exercise. Waiting & listening to God should always lead a person to serve God in a deeper manner through service, evangelism, and spiritual gifts.	
* Fill out the WEEKLY LOG.	
* You will be required to spend over 40 hours on this discipline [you can take 16 – 24 weeks].

MY PRAYER LIFE 1 (MPL-1)

STUDY GUIDE: MY PRAYER LIFE 1 (MPL-1)

TEXTBOOK/MATERIAL:

BIBLE see: www.altogetherlovely.org/useful-links

REQUIREMENTS:

As an anointed child of God, you will be required to pray to God as well as let God speak to you. This should be done in the Power of the Holy Spirit with a heart open to God. We can't and don't know how to pray. So we need to ask God to fill us with His Holy Spirit so we can pray in the Spirit of God.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Set aside 15 minutes/day (24 weeks) or 25 minutes/day (16 weeks) for prayer.	
* Follow the following format for prayer:	
1 st) Ask God to fill you with His Holy Spirit. Then confess any unknown/known sin in your life. We don't know how to pray to God. We need His Holy Spirit to give us the Power and Unction to pray. Upon sensing God's presence, go to the next step.	
2 nd) After you've been filled with the Holy Spirit, begin to worship God from your heart. Praise Him for who He is, what He's done, and for His Salvation in your life.	
3 rd) Let the Holy Spirit lead you here now. God may lead you into:	
	<i>deeper confession of sin (1 John 1:9)</i>
	<i>deeper thanksgiving and worship</i>
	<i>praying for your needs and/or the needs of others</i>
4 th) Finally, Ask God to give you a desire to pray and commune with Him all day.	
* Prayer can be done all day long, morning/noon/night, at meals, walking down the street, etc. We should constantly be in a state of prayer ("Devote yourself to prayer being watchful and thankful" Colossians 4:2). The mistake most Christians make is they don't realize that they need to constantly be in communion & prayer with God through the day.	
* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week.	
* A minimum of over 40 hours is required [you can take 16 – 24 weeks].	

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Set aside a certain time of the day for prayer. Protect this time.
- Find a position that is not too comfortable. There is no "proper" position for prayer. Find a position that you will feel comfortable but not too comfortable so you don't fall asleep. Throughout the Bible, people prayed on their knees, on their stomachs, on the cross, in gardens, by themselves, with others, at different times of the day, etc.
- Stay in a state of humility towards God. Keep your heart soft and open to God. Enjoy the beautiful fellowship with God that we have in Christ.
- Trust God to help you with your prayer life in the future. Make it the "first" thing you do, not something you do when everything else is done.

REQUIREMENTS:

The Spirit-filled child of God will be led to worship Jesus for 15 minutes every day for 24 weeks (this should be a part of our daily Christian devotions)

INSTRUCTIONS:

* You will worship Jesus for 15 minutes/day (24 weeks) or 25 minutes/day (16 weeks).
* The worship can be done through Christian music, Spirit-led worship, or verbal praise.
* You may use also verbally say the Psalms, free-worship from your heart, and use the resources on the next few pages.

People are trying to fill the emptiness inside instead of filling it with God. Fasting is supernatural. You will actually feel God’s power and His filling.
- Don’t make this “religious”. The main purpose of fasting is to draw closer to God through prayer and denying your flesh. When finished, take time to thank God for His power to fast.

INTERCESSORY PRAYER 1 (IP-1)

STUDY GUIDE: INTERCESSORY PRAYER 1 (IP-1)

REQUIREMENTS:

As an anointed child of God, you will be required to intercede for others for 15 - 25 minutes each day. This should be done in the Power of the Holy Spirit with a heart open to God.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* Pray 15 minutes/day for 24 weeks or 25 minutes/day for 16 weeks for others.	
* Follow the following format for prayer:	
1st) Ask God to fill you with His Holy Spirit. Then confess any unknown/known sin in your life. We don't know how to pray to God. That is why we need His Holy Spirit to give us the Power and Direction to pray. Once you sense God's presence, go to step 2.	
2nd) After you've been filled with the Holy Spirit (by faith), begin to ask God to put different people on your heart to pray for.	
3rd) Let the Holy Spirit lead you here now. God may lead you into:	
	* praying for your family, pastor, leaders, or church members
	* praying for missionaries, different people groups, different countries.
4th) Finally, Ask God to give you a desire to intercede all day. Intercessory Prayer can be done all day long, morning/noon/night, at meals, walking down the street, etc. We should constantly be in a state of prayer ("Devote yourself to prayer being watchful and thankful" Colossians 4:2). The mistake most Christians make is they don't realize that they need to constantly be in communion & prayer with God through the day.

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- e) Set aside a certain time of the day for prayer. Protect this time.
- f) Find a position that is not too comfortable. There is no "proper" position for prayer. Find a position that you will feel comfortable but not too comfortable so you don't fall asleep. Throughout the Bible, people prayed on their knees, on their stomachs, on the cross, in gardens, by themselves, with others, at different times of day, etc.
- g) Stay in a state of humility towards God. Keep your heart soft and open to God. Realize by faith that God is moving the universe for your prayers.
- h) Trust God to help you with your intercessory prayer life in the future. Make it the "first" thing you do, not something you do when everything else is done.
- i) Be open to go and interview someone in your church who is known as an intercessory prayer warrior.

* Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week.
