Galatians 3:10-13

- 10. All who rely on observing the law are under a curse, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law."
- 11. Clearly no one is justified before God by the law, because, "The righteous will live by faith."
- 12. The law is not based on faith; on the contrary, "The man who does these things will live by them."
- 13. Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."

Christ's Sufferings Not Physical Alone

- John Calvin: "If Christ had died only a bodily death, it would have been ineffectual...Unless his soul shared in the punishment, he would have been the Redeemer of bodies alone."
- † He is the Savior of our spirit, soul, body.
- * "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us" (Gal.3:13)

Jesus Experienced Guilt Before the Father

Jesus Had Never Experienced Sin

- † John 8:29 "The One who sent Me is with Me. He has not left Me alone, because I always do what pleases Him."
- † John 15:10 "I have kept My Father's commands and remain in His love."
- † Hebrews 4:15 He was "tested in every way as we are, yet without sin"
- † Hebrews 7:26-27 He is "Holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners..."

Jesus Experienced The Guilt of Our Sin

- † 2 Corinthians 5:21 "He made the One who did not know sin to be sin for us..."
- † 1 Peter 2:24 "He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree..."
- † Isaiah 53:12 "He bore the sin of many"

Jesus Experienced the Wrath of the Father

Jesus Had Never Experienced the Father's Displeasure

† John 8:29 "I always do what pleases Him"

Jesus Knew What Was Coming And Dreaded It

- † Matthew 26:37 "He began to be sorrowful and deeply distressed"
- † Mark 14:33 "He began to be deeply distressed and horrified."
- * Mark 14:34 "He said to them, 'My soul is swallowed up in sorrow—to the point of death'"
- tuke 22:43 "Then an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him."

Prayed to Avoid

- * Matthew 26:39 "He fell facedown and prayed, 'My Father! If it is possible, let this cup pass from Me. Yet not as I will, but as You will."
- tuke 22:44 "Being in anguish, He prayed more fervently, and His sweat became like drops of blood falling to the ground."

It Was the Cup of God's Wrath

- † Jeremiah 25:15 "This cup of the wine of wrath"
- † Isaiah 51:17 "The cup of His fury"
- *Revelation 14:10 "The wine of God's wrath, which is mixed full strength in the cup of His anger"
- † Revelation 16:19 "The cup filled with the wine of His fierce anger."

Jesus Lived in Perfect Communion with the Father

- † John 16:32 "I am not alone, because the Father is with Me."
- † John 17:21-22 "You, Father, are in Me and I am in You... We are one"

* Matthew 27:46 "At about three in the afternoon Jesus cried out with a loud voice... 'My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?'"

If a man guilty of a capital offense is put to death and his body is hung on a tree, you must not leave his body on the tree overnight. Be sure to bury him that same day, because anyone who is hung on a tree is under God's curse. You must not desecrate the land the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance. (Deuteronomy 21:22-23)

When Christ came to this world He knew He would be "cursed" and "hung on a tree".

How did He know?

He had written the words Himself,

"Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."

Yet, He became a curse for us so we could be redeemed from the curse of the law. "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
