A. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING - (A-1a Low Beginner)

These 6 courses/disciplines will lay the needed foundations for Biblical English.

Online English-1 [4 Disciplines] [OE-1]: This major Discipline uses the #1 online secular English program (LEVEL 1). It teaches listening, speaking, voice recognition, reading, and writing all integrated with natural grammar. Teaches English just as you would learn a native language with real life situations and native speakers. Either a monthly online fee or bought on CD ROM. [See: www.rosettastone.com]. 6 hours/wk (48 wks) req.

Let's Learn Biblical English-1 [LLBE-1]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course in a self-prepared class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of 3 or more people to multiply yourself. This Biblical ESL/EFL course is for "LOW BEGINNER LEVEL" language learners. It teaches basic reading and phonics as well as Bible Scripture. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to make extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs/wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs /wk (12 wks) required.

Bible Writing & Oration 1a [BWO-1a]: God's child will be required to write the New Testament of the Bible. AT THE SAME TIME, you will be required to "SPEAK" the words you are writing. This causes a person to slow down, listen to God, and hear God's voice in a deeper way. 16 to 24 weeks required.

IN BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING:

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (A-1a; A-1b; A-2a; A-2b; A-3a; A-3b) for a 1 year program.

A. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING - (A-1b Low Beginner)

These 6 courses/disciplines will help deepen the needed foundations for Biblical English.

Bible Writing & Oration-1b [4 Disciplines] [BWO-1b]: This major Discipline will require God's child to write the Old Testament of the Bible. AT THE SAME TIME, you will be required to "SPEAK" the words you are writing. This causes a person to slow down and listen to God as well as to hear God's voice in a deeper manner. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Let's Learn Biblical English-2 [LLBE-2]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course in a self-prepared class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of 3 or more people to multiply yourself. This Biblical ESL/EFL course is for "LOW BEGINNER LEVEL" language learners. It teaches basic reading and phonics as well as Bible Scripture. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs/wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs /wk (12 wks) required.

Bible Reading-1a [BR-1a]: God's child will be required to read the New Testament. This should be led by prayer each time with an expectation to be spoken to by God. 16 to 24 weeks required.

IN BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING:

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (A-1a; A-1b; A-2a; A-2b; A-3a; A-3b) for a 1 year program.

A. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING - (A-2a Middle – High Beginner)

These 6 courses/disciplines will help you advance in Biblical English.

Online English-2 [5 Disciplines] [OE-2]: This major Discipline uses the #1 online secular English program (LEVEL 2). It teaches listening, speaking, voice recognition, reading, and writing all integrated with natural grammar. Teaches English just as you would learn a native language with real life situations and native speakers. Can be used online for a monthly fee or bought on CD ROM. See: www.rosettastone.com . 7 hours/wk for 1 year required.

Let's Learn Biblical English-3 [LLBE-3]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course in a self-prepared class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of 3 or more people to multiply yourself. This Biblical ESL/EFL course is for "MIDDLE to HIGH BEGINNER LEVEL" language learners. It teaches basic reading and phonics as well as Bible Scripture. . [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to make extra books for you and your class].. 2 hrs/wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs /wk (12 wks) required.

IN BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING:

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (A-1a; A-1b; A-2a; A-2b; A-3a; A-3b) for a 1 year program.

A. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING - (A-2b High Beginner – Low Intermediate)

These 6 courses/disciplines will help deepen the needed foundations for Biblical English.

Bible Reading-1b [3 Disciplines] [BR-1b]: God's child will be required to read the whole Bible (Genesis to Revelation). This should be led by prayer each time with an expectation to be spoken to by God. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Bible Audio-1 [2 Disciplines] [BA-1]: The "anointed child of God" will be required to listen to an Audio Bible. You will listen to the NT (2x), Psalms (2x), and Proverbs (2x). We encourage you to follow along in your Bible at the same time. Substitutes are available if you have no access to Audio Bibles. [see www.altogetherlovely.org/useful-links (Biblical ESL Resources) & RESOURCES / OUR BOOKSTORE on our website for audio bibles]. 16-24 weeks required.

Experiencing Christian Biblical English-1 [ECBE-1]: God's child will be required to participate in this prepared course in a self-prepared class. You will participate as a "trainee" and be required to form a small group of three students to multiply yourself. This Biblical ESL/EFL course is for "HIGH BEGINNER TO LOW INTERMEDIATE LEVEL" language learners. . [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to make extra books for you and your class].. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

IN BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING:

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (A-1a; A-1b; A-2a; A-2b; A-3a; A-3b) for a 1 year program.

A. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TRAINING - (A-3a High Intermediate - Advanced)

This Biblical ESL/EFL course is for "HIGH INTERMEDIATE to ADVANCED LEVEL" language learners. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to make extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

Thesis/Internship-1 [5 Disciplines] [TIS-1]: The Lord's gifted child will be required to develop this five discipline area. You may choose to write a thesis, memorize Scripture in your new language, write out Scriptures, do more Bible study, etc. This should be something that you enjoy and are willing to make a commitment to your further growth in Biblical ESL/EFL training. 16-24 weeks required.

REQUIREMENTS:

God's child will be required to WRITE the New Testament of the Bible. AT THE SAME TIME, you will be required to "SPEAK" the words you are writing. This discipline causes a person to slow down and listen to God as well as being able to hear God's voice in a deeper manner.

INSTRUCTIONS:

WRITE the New Testament of the Bible.
Speak the words "OUTLOUD" as you write.
If needed, look up words in a dictionary as you go.
Make a "disciplined plan" to follow each week. For example: 200 NT pages over 24 weeks (8 page/week) = about 2 hours a week or 48 hours.
Do this on a DAILY BASIC. Be disciplined. Not by "your power" but with God's Power.
Make daily notes of what you've written OR underline important things God shows you.
Complete the Weekly log each week.
Minimum Required Time: 40 hours [can be done over 16 – 24 weeks]

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Pray before you start writing. Don't start reading until you sense the Holy Spirit prompting you to begin.
- Write from your "spirit" as much as possible. This is a wonderful way in which to commune with God. Stay in a constant state of "spiritual awareness".
- If you find yourself just "writing and speaking", stop, and ask God to forgive you. God wants to talk to you.
- You may want to "underline" something as you read it. Or you may want to make notes of something God has spoken to you.
- When you are finish, take some time to thank God for His power to write, speak, and look up words. Thank God for talking to you. He's a personal, loving God.

ONE LAST NOTE

The student may find ONLINE study to be somewhat different from that of the On-Campus Study. However, if the student will follow the instructions, the learning will be in-depth.

REQUIREMENTS:

God's child will be required to READ the New Testament. This is a marvelous way to grow closer to God, hear God's voice, get direction for a person's life, and get to know God in a deeper manner.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* READ the New Testament of the Bible.
* To begin, count the number of pages in your Bible that you are to read. Then read one page and "time" yourself. Then calculate how much time you will need to "look up" words in your dictionary.
* Now, decide how long you want to take to complete this course. In 24 weeks, if, for example, a page takes you 10 minutes to read and 5 minutes to look up words, then calculate the time needed to complete in the 24 weeks. Remember, this is a "discipline" that you can use in the future. Protect this time each day.
