Each segment is 6 Disciplines. Two segments (12 Disciplines) is a 1 year degree program.



G. LAY COUNSELING: LAY COUNSELING (G-1) / LAY COUNSELING (G-2)

G. LAY COUNSELING (G-1)

These 6 courses/disciplines help you develop your spiritual gifts in counseling.

Ministering to Deaf, Blind, & Disabled-1 [2 Disciplines] [MDBD-1]: As a believer, you are to pray, then seek out someone deaf, blind, or disabled. Most importantly, try to be a friend to them. Try to understand their struggles, joys, and life. You may want to volunteer for a ministry that helps the deaf, blind, disabled and also ministers to their needs both spiritually and physically. We also encourage you to study "sign language" or "Braille". 16 to 24 weeks required.

Teaching Experiencing God's Love-1 [TEGL-1]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course. You will participate as a "teacher" and be required to form a small group of yourself and two students to multiply yourself. This is a basic Christian healing course to interactively and experientially lead people through inner healing. Make sure they are well acquainted in the foundations of Christianity. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

Healing Prayer and Counseling-1 [HPC-1]: Ask God to send you or help you find a person with spiritual needs and offer your services to pray for them on a weekly basis. Be a trusted, discerning, loving person (man to man – woman to woman) and just listen and then pray for them. This course fits very nicely with the book on inner healing. Have them pray with you in areas of repentance, inner healing, and forgiveness. Humility and trust is a must. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Counseling Pre-Marriage Couples-1 [CPMC-1]: You will be asked to find people who are dating. Prepare a questionnaire about questions that they should consider before getting married. Ask about God's role in their future marriage and how God can help them stay committed to each other. Discover their vision for the Kingdom and how they can obtain it. You may also interview married couples about their marriages. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Helping God's Children-1 [HGC-1]: We are to minister to WIDOWS, PRISONERS, THE ELDERLY, THE SICK, ORPHANS, AND SINGLE PARENTS. Choose one or more of these ministry areas. Then learn about it through reading, talking to secular/Christian counselors, and talking to family members & individuals. Be sensitive & caring. 16 to 24 weeks required.

G. LAY COUNSELING (G-2)

These 6 courses/disciplines help develop spiritual gifts in counseling & touch the heart to the hurting world's needs.

Counseling and Discipleship-1 [2 Disciplines] [CDS-1]: Lead someone to Christ or ask your pastor to allow you to counsel/disciple a new convert or person who desires to grow in Christ. Be a trusted, discerning, loving person (man to man – woman to woman) and just listen and pray for them. This course fits very nicely with the inner healing book. Be open to having them pray with you in areas of repentance, inner healing, and forgiveness. Humility is a must here. Make sure they are acquainted in the Christian basics. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Teaching Experiencing God's Love-2 [TEGL-2]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course. You will participate as a "teacher" and asked form a small group of yourself and two students minimum to multiply yourself. This is a basic Christian healing and evangelism course to interactively & experientially lead people thru inner healing & Christian growth. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

Abortion, Divorce, and Aids-1 [ADA-1]: The born again believer should take time to study on "abortion". Then do a study about God's view of abortion, His forgiveness to those who abort their child, and the spiritual/emotional/guilt consequences of abortions. Be very conscious of the fact that many times young teenagers are forced into abortions by parents, doctors, etc. without being mature enough to know the consequences. ALSO: use the same method to study about DIVORCE and AIDS. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Understanding Addictions-1 [UA-1]: SEXUAL addictions, ALCOHOLISM, NARCOTICS addictions, AND FOOD addictions are just some of the addictions many people struggle with. You are to research each of these addictions. Then talk to counselors (secular and Christian) about these topics. Find out about support groups available and useful websites. If you have an opportunity, minister to someone in this area. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Grieving and Loss-1 [GAL-1]: As one who "mourns with those who mourn" you will be asked to study "grieving and loss". This will involve people who have lost family members, etc. You may have a chance to compassionately "be" with someone who is going through the grieving process. Be a "COMFORT" and a "LISTENER". Talk to a counselor about this ministry area. 16 to 24 weeks required.



Lay Counseling (G-1)

COUNSELING PRE-MARRIAGE COUPLES 1 (CPMC-1)

STUDY GUIDE: COUNSELING PRE-MARRIAGE COUPLES 1 (CPMC-1)

TEXTBOOK/MATERIAL:

REQUIREMENTS:

You will be asked to find a couple who are led by God to marry. Prepare a questionnaire regarding questions that they should consider before getting married. Talk to married couples about their marriages. You will also take time to study about Christian marriage.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- * To begin, prepare a questionnaire regarding questions that young couples should consider before getting married.
- * Write questions about God's role in marriage and how God can help couples stay committed to each other. Inquire about their vision for the Kingdom and how they can obtain it. Explain that Christians don't date, kiss, etc. before marriage that they should learn to first be brothers/sisters in Christ and then hear God's voice about marriage or not. Find out what they feel God's purpose in their marriage is. Find out how many children they want, should the wife work, etc.
 - * We also suggest you read one of the recommended books at the end of this syllabus.
- * You may also want to study Scripture about "marriage & divorce" in the Bible (see also: New Unger's Bible Dictionary, Fausset's Bible Dictionary, Easton's Bible Dictionary, Nave's Topical Bible, Nelson's Bible Dictionary under resources at the end of this syllabus).
 - * You may want to do the Bible study in this syllabus also.
- * Then consult young couples (engaged or not). Ask them if they are willing to help you do some pre-marriage counseling. Interview different couples.
- * Then interview married couples to find out what things they have done right or wrong in their marriage.
 - * Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week [you may take 16-24 weeks].
 - * 40 hours is the minimum requirement for this Discipline.
 - * We recommend you spend 20 hours interviewing people and 20 hours reading and studying about Christian marriage and God's plan for it.

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

 Pray before you begin. Ask God to give you wisdom in this area. Be focused on learning about marriage and God's plan. When you are finish, take some time to thank God for His power to help you learn about Christian marriage. God has a wonderful plan for marriage.

Often punished by being debarred from (Jer 7:34; 16:9; 25:10); Were allowed divorce from, because of hardness of their hearts (De 24:1; Mt 19:7,8); Exempted from going to war immediately after (De 20:7).

Priest not to contract, with divorced or improper persons (Le 21:7).

The high priest not to contract, with a widow or a divorced or profane person (Le 21:14).

Be a trusted, discerning, loving person (man to man – woman to woman) and "listen" and pray for them. This course fits very nicely with the book on inner healing. You should be open to having them pray with you in areas of repentance, inner healing, and forgiveness. Humility and trust is a must.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- * Pray for God to lead you in preparing this Discipline.
- * To begin, pray for God to send you someone that you can disciple and pray for. You may even ask a church counselor to let you sit in on some sessions.
- * Meet with them for 1 ¾ hours/week (24 weeks) or 2 ¾ hours/week (16 weeks). You may want to meet with two people.
- * The best way to counsel is to 1) establish a relationship, 2) be a listener, 3) make sure they feel like you "hear" them, 4) explain you are here to "listen and pray for them", 5) don't give advice help them discover what they need to do, 6) pray for them before and at the end of every meeting. You are not a professional counselor but a Spirit-filled child of God willing to be a vessel for the Holy Spirit to work through.
- * You may also want to read one of the recommended books at the end of this syllabus.
 - * You may also want to do the Bible Study in this syllabus.
 - * Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week [you may take 16-24 weeks].
 - * 40 hours is the minimum required for this discipline.

REQUIREMENTS:

We are to minister to WIDOWS, PRISONERS, THE ELDERLY, THE SICK, ORPHANS, AND SINGLE PARENTS. You are to ask God to give you a heart to minister to one or two of these groups of people. Find someone ministering to these people and ask them if you can be discipled or taught how to minister to these groups of people. Do your best to be sensitive and caring.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- * Pray for wisdom in preparing this Discipline.
- * To begin, ask God to guide you in finding a mature Christian to disciple you in ministering to people. They should be someone presently ministering to WIDOWS, PRISONERS, THE ELDERLY, THE SICK, ORPHANS, or SINGLE PARENTS. Spend 1 ½ hours a week (8 weeks) being discipled by this person [12 hours].
- * Then, together or by yourself, begin to minister to these people. Listen, help, pray and care about their lives. Be sensitive to them. Also be sensitive to how you will "continue" or "end" the relationship after a while. Spend 1 ½ hours/week (16 weeks) or 3 hours/week (8 weeks).
- * We also suggest you read one of the recommended books at the end of this syllabus. You are to also study Scripture about "Evangelism" in the Bible (see also: New Unger's Bible Dictionary, Fausset's Bible Dictionary, Easton's Bible Dictionary, Nave's Topical Bible, Nelson's Bible Dictionary under resources at the end of this syllabus).
 - * You may want to do the Bible Study in this syllabus.
 - * Then complete the WEEKLY LOG each week [you may take 16-24 weeks].
 - * 40 hours is the minimum requirement for this Discipline

- * Finally, you are to learn about 12 STEP programs as a means of being set free from addictions. The 12 Steps is Christianity. The secular world has used it very effectively. Jesus is the "power" behind the 12 Steps for the Christian.
 - * You may want to do the personal Bible Study below.
 - * Complete the WEEKLY LOG each week [you may take 16-24 weeks].
 - * 40 hours is the minimum required for this Discipline.
