1. Calling of a Spiritual Leader/ Disciple

And He said to them,

"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."

(Matthew 4:19)

2. Traits of Leadership

- a. Authority is received from God, 2 Cor 13:10;Jn 5:27
- b. Not to be served but to serve, safely (Ps 78:53), gently (Is 40:11), faithfully (Deut 8:2, 15)
- c. Essence not in having, but in giving life, edification, 1 Cor 14:26
- d. To construct and not destruct, Jn 17:2
- e. Involves Account giving to God, Heb 13:17

3. Disciplines of a Leader

a. Drawing a line of resistance and Training our appetites

(Resist it early enough and train yourself with the fruit of the Holy Spirit, Gal 5:22)

- Physical hunger: Managed by Self Control
- Emotional hunger: Managed by Patience
- Intellectual hunger: Managed by pursuit of Peace
- Relational hunger: Managed by Love and discipline
- Spiritual hunger: Managed by Faith & faithfulness

b. Draw the Line of Dependence

For Wisdom: Like Daniel, Daniel 2:20

For Provision: Like Elijah,1 Kings 17:2

- For Protection: Like Gideon, Jud 6:36-38

For Resilience: Like Samson, Judges 16:28

c. Draw the Line of confidence

- On God's Word: Like Paul, in shipwreck, Acts
 27:22-25
- In prayer, 1 John 5:14, 15
- In God's promises, Phil 1:6
- In God's perfect Will, Phil 1: 25, 26

4. Gifts of a Leader

- a. Gifts of Insight: Word of Wisdom, Word of Knowledge, Discerning of Spirits
- b. Gifts of Power: Faith, Working of Miracles, Gifts of Healing
- c. Gifts of Communication: Prophecy, Different Kinds of tongues, Interpretation of tongues

5. Leader's Role in the Church

- a. Apostles: Men divinely commissioned as Christ's mission representatives ...
 - To establish churches, Eph 2:20
 - Uphold discipline 2 Cor 13:1-6
 - To perform miracles, as demonstration of God's love and power, Rom 15:19-20

- b. Prophets: Inspired messenger ...
 - To predict future, Acts 21:10-11
 - To define God's Will, Acts 13:1-3

- c. Evangelists: One who proclaims Good news ...
 - A distinct ministry, Eph 4:11, Acts 21:8 (Philip), to win souls

- d. Shepherds: One who cares for the sheep ...
 - Know their sheep, Jn 10:3-5
 - Search for the Lost, Lk 15:4-5
- e. Teachers: Rabbi meaning 'my master'
 - Teach God's way: Ps 27:11
 - Teach Holiness: Titus 2:12
 - Teach Spiritual Truth: Heb 8:11-12
- f. Administrators (Helps): Those who bear another's burden
 - Gift to the Church: 1 Cor 12:28
 - Be on guard, for themselves and the Church: Acts 20: 28,
 35

6. Leader's Role in the Society

a. Service in the Inner court (Caring for the soul): come near (lead people to repentance), minister to God (worship), stand before him (intercede), Ezek 44:15

b. Service in the outer court of human need (Caring for the poor), Mt 25:40

7. Leader's role at Home

a. Guarding the unity of the couple (One flesh), Gen 2:24

b. Raise a God-fearing generation, by diligently governing his household matters, 1 Tim 3:4-5
