BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TEACHING & LANGUAGE (B-1a) (B-1b) (B-2a) (B-2b) (B-3a) (B-3b)

B. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TEACHING & LANGUAGE - (B-1a)

These 6 courses/disciplines will solidify foundations for Teaching Biblical English. It also teaches you higher proficiency in a second or foreign language.

Online Language-1 [4 Disciplines] [OL-1]: This major Discipline uses the #1 online secular language program (LEVEL #1). It teaches listening, speaking, voice recognition, reading, and writing all integrated with natural grammar. Teaches languages just as you would learn a native language with real life situations and native speakers. Can be used online (monthly fee) or bought on CD ROM. [See: www.rosettastone.com to order Rosetta Stone]. 6 hrs/wk for 1 year required.

Teaching Let's Learn Biblical English-1 [TLLBE-1]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course in class. You will be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum and teach this Biblical ESL/EFL course for "LOW BEGINNER LEVEL" language learners. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print books for your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

Bible Writing & Oration-1a [BWO-1a]: God's child will be required to write the New Testament of the Bible. AT THE SAME TIME, you will be required to "SPEAK" the words you are writing. This discipline causes a person to slow down and listen to God as well as being able to hear God's voice in a deeper manner. 16 to 24 weeks required.

FOR NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Online Language-1 and Bible Writing / Oration-1a in English. This will help you improve your own English language ability while you learn to teach.

FOR NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Online Language-1 and Bible Writing/Oration-1a in a language other than English. This will help you understand and sympathize with the language learner as well as increase your effectiveness in the Kingdom of God as you learn to teach.

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (B-1a; B-1b; B-2a; B-2b; B-3a; B-3b) for a 1 year program.

This discipline causes a person to slow down and listen to God as well as being able to hear God's voice in a deeper manner. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Teaching Let's Learn Biblical English-2 [TLLBE-2]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course in class. You will be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum and teach this Biblical ESL/EFL course for "LOW BEGINNER LEVEL" language learners. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print books for your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

Bible Reading-1a [BR-1a]: God's child will be required to read the New Testament of the Bible (Matthew to Revelation). This should be led by prayer each time with an expectation to be spoken to by God. 16 to 24 weeks required.

FOR NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Bible Reading-1a and Bible Writing/Oration-1b in English. This will help you improve your English language ability while you learn to teach.

FOR NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Bible Reading-1a and Bible Writing/Oration-1b in a language other than English. This will help you understand the language learner and increase your effectiveness.

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (B-1a; B-1b; B-2a; B-2b; B-3a; B-3b) for a 1 year program.

B. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TEACHING & LANGUAGE - (B-2a)

These 6 courses/disciplines solidify the needed foundations for Teaching Biblical English. It also teaches you higher proficiency in a second or foreign language.

Online Language-2 [5 Disciplines] [OE-2]: This major Discipline uses the #1 online secular English program (LEVEL 2). It teaches listening, speaking, voice recognition, reading, and writing all integrated with natural grammar. Teaches English just as you would learn a native language with real life situations and native speakers. Can be used online for a monthly fee or bought on CD ROM. [See: www.rosettastone.com to order Rosetta Stone]. 7 hrs/wk (for 1 year) required.

Teaching Let's Learn Biblical English-3 [TLLBE-3]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course in class. You will be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum and teach this Biblical ESL/EFL course for "MIDDLE to HIGH BEGINNER LEVEL" language learners. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to printextra books for your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

FOR NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Online Language-2 in English. This will help you improve your own English language ability while you learn to teach.

FOR NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Online Language-2 in a language other than English. This will help you sympathize with the language learner as well as increase your effectiveness as you learn to teach.

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (B-1a; B-1b; B-2a; B-2b; B-3a; B-3b) for a 1 year program.

B. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TEACHING & LANGUAGE - (B-2b)

These 6 courses/disciplines solidify the needed foundations for Teaching Biblical English. It also teaches you higher proficiency in a second or foreign language.

Bible Reading-1b [3 Disciplines] [BR-1b]: God's child will be required to read the Old Testament and New Testament of the Bible (Genesis to Revelation). This should be led by prayer each time with an expectation to be spoken to by God. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Bible Audio-1 [2 Disciplines] [BA-1]: The "anointed child of God" will be required to listen to an Audio Bible. You will listen to the NT (2x), Psalms (2x), and Proverbs (2x). We also encourage you to follow along in your Bible at the same time. Substitutes are available if you have no access to Audio Bibles. [see www.altogetherlovely.org/useful-links for Biblical English Resources listen audio bibles]. 16 to 24 weeks required.

Teaching Experiencing Christian Biblical English-1 [TECBE-1]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course in class. You will be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum and teach this Biblical ESL/EFL course for "HIGH BEGINNER TO LOW INTERMEDIATE LEVEL" language learners. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

FOR NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Bible Audio-1 and Bible Reading-1b in English. This will help you improve your own English language ability while you learn to teach.

FOR NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Bible Audio-1 and Bible Reading-1b in a language other than English. This will help you understand and sympathize with the language learner as well as increase your effectiveness in the Kingdom of God as you learn to teach.

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (B-1a; B-1b; B-2a; B-2b; B-3a; B-3b) for a 1 year program.

B. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TEACHING & LANGUAGE - (B-3a)

These 6 courses/disciplines further prepare you to Teach Biblical English. Learning to teach is a life long experience. It also teaches you higher proficiency in a second or foreign language.

Online Language-3 [5 Disciplines] [OE-3]: This major Discipline uses the #1 online secular English program (LEVEL 3). It teaches listening, speaking, voice recognition, reading, and writing all integrated with natural grammar. Teaches English just as you would learn a native language with real life situations and native speakers. Can be used online for a monthly fee or bought on CD ROM. [See: www.rosettastone.com to order Rosetta Stone]. 7 hrs/wk (for 1 year) required.

Teaching Experiencing Christian Biblical English-2 [TECBE-2]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course in class. You will be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum and teach this Biblical ESL/EFL course for "HIGH INTERMEDIATE to ADVANCED LEVEL" language learners. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

FOR NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will NOT BE ABLE TO TAKE THESE DISCIPLINES. GO TO (B-3b) below. You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (B-1a; B-1b; B-2a; B-2b; B-3a; B-3b) for a 1 year program.

B. BIBLICAL ESL/EFL TEACHING & LANGUAGE - (B-3b)

These 6 courses/disciplines deepen the needed foundations for Teaching Biblical English. Learning to teach is a life long experience. It also teaches you higher proficiency in a second or foreign language.

Teaching Experiencing Christian Biblical English-3 [TECBE-3]: God's child will be required to teach this prepared course in class. You will be required to form a small group of two students and yourself minimum and teach this Biblical ESL/EFL course for "ADVANCED LEVEL" language learners. [SEE www.altogetherlovely.org/resources to print extra books for you and your class]. 2 hrs / wk (24 wks) or 4 hrs / wk (12 wks) required.

Thesis/Internship-1 [5 Disciplines] [TIS-1]: The Lord's gifted child will be required to develop this four discipline area. You may choose to write a thesis, memorize Scripture in your new language, write out Scriptures, do more Bible study, etc. This should be something that you enjoy and are willing to make a commitment to your further growth in Teaching Biblical ESL/EFL. 16-24 weeks required.

FOR NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to do Thesis/Internship-1 in a way that will improve your English ability. This will help you improve your own English language ability while you learn to teach.

FOR NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to do Thesis/Internship-1 in a way that will improve your new language (geared to improving the language you are studying). This will help you understand and sympathize with the language learner as well as increase your effectiveness in the Kingdom of God as you learn to teach.

You can select any two (6 Discipline) programs (B-1a; B-1b; B-2a; B-2b; B-3a; B-3b) for a 1 year program.

FOR NON-NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Online Language 1 (OL-1) and Bible Writing/Oration 1a (BWO-1a) in English. This will help you improve your own English language ability while you learn to teach.

FOR NATIVE ENGLISH SPEAKERS: You will be required to study Online Language 1 (OL-1) and Bible Writing/Oration 1a (BWO-1a) in a language other than English. This will help you understand and sympathize with the language learner as well as increase your effectiveness in the Kingdom of God as you learn to teach.

REQUIREMENTS:

God's child will be required to WRITE the New Testament of the Bible. AT THE SAME TIME, you will be required to "SPEAK" the words you are writing. This discipline causes a person to slow down and listen to God as well as being able to hear God's voice in a deeper manner.

INSTRUCTIONS:

* If needed, look up words in a dictionary as you go.

* Make a "disciplined plan" to follow each week.

For example: 200 NT pages over 24 weeks (8 page/week) = about 2 hours a week or 48 hours.

* Do this on a DAILY BASIC. Be disciplined. Not by "your power" but with God's Power.

* Make daily notes of what you've written. Write or underline important things God shows you.

* Complete the Weekly log each week.

* Minimum Required Time: 40 hours [you can take 16-24 weeks].

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF THIS COURSE:

In order to get the most out of this course, we recommend the following:

- Pray before you start writing. Don't start reading until you sense the Holy Spirit prompting you to begin. Write from your "spirit" as much as possible. This is a wonderful way in which to commune with God. Stay in a constant state of "spiritual awareness". If you find yourself just "writing and speaking", stop, and ask God to forgive you. God wants to talk to you.
- You may want to "underline" something as you read it. Or you may want to make notes of something God has spoken to you. When you finish, take time to thank God for His power to write, speak, look up words, & talk to you. He's a personalGod.

ONE LAST NOTE

The student may find ONLINE study to be somewhat different from that of the On-Campus Study. However, if the student will follow the instructions, the learning will be in-depth.

External studies take much self-discipline. If extra help is needed, feel free to contact your school leadership (Attention: Course Help). May the Lord bless you as you study and prepare this discipline. "He is altogether lovely" (Song of Songs 5:16).
